

Research Universities of the Year 2012

Three universities gain RESEARCH Infosource's designation of *Research University of the Year* in their category for their performance on a balanced set of input, output and impact measures for FY2011. These full-service universities demonstrated superior achievement both in earning research income and in publishing research in leading scientific journals.

*The Score in each category is out of a possible 100 points based on the following indicators and weighting: 2 input measures: total sponsored research income (20%), and research intensity (20%); 2 output measures: total number of publications (20%) and publication intensity in leading journals (20%), and 1 impact measure: publication impact (20%). For each measure, the top ranking institution is assigned a score of 100 and the other institutions' scores are calculated as a percentage of the first ranking institution. To be eligible to be included in the Research Universities of the Year Tier Group rankings, universities must rank in the top 50% in their respective tier group for at least 3 out of the 5 measures.
